Dear Covid Volunteers,

A huge thank you for your tremendous work during the covid crisis. Your help has been a lifeline to many. Even those who did not use the service felt enormously comforted that it was there for them. I hope we all feel proud of our village communities and a renewed sense of community spirit.

At our Covid Volunteers meeting today, the last day of the shielding programme, we discussed how to thank volunteers and will be writing out soon. Then at Harvest Festival time we aim to make a further special thanks and certificates as appropriate. We will have a commemorative bench at Witham St Hughs and a gathering requested in the cliff villages when that is feasible, perhaps in September/October.

We heard from Dan Quinn, of the Lincolnshire Resilience Forum, co-ordinating the response from the public services. His concerns of a second or continuing wave, especially if a different crisis hits at the same time helped us recognise the need to keep our volunteer groups intact and to build on the important sense of local community spirit.

A key message for us to share with our communities is the importance of continued social distancing, masks and 20 sec hand-washing to prevent the disease spreading and avoid going back into lock-down.



Dan Quinn raised two other increased risks we now face; mental health, especially linked to the local economy and unemployment, risen by 41% in three months so far.

Christine Goldsmith, the Rector of four villages, suggested volunteer training, such as mental health first aiders, to help our volunteers identify where professional help is needed. This is especially important in our agricultural county at this current time. Thanks to the *Rural network* and the *Emergency Faith Responders* for their support.

Dan Quinn was thanked for all the co-ordination work done by him and the members of the resilience forum. Marianne thanks all our volunteers for the fantastic job done and emphasised the need for continuing support. You are invited to join the group, the next meeting of the volunteer groups on Friday 28th August at 10am on Zoom.

National Work

Meetings with ministers and leading Councillors and Mayors from across the country this month, have focussed on funding for council services, getting culture and tourism up and running, and supporting retail and transport. I invite 32 Independent group Council Leaders to meet fortnightly and other national meetings have focussed on the fire safety, and devolution of powers to our councils.

The government promised devolution of powers and money to local government, but the idea of requiring costly and time-consuming reorganisation of our councils, was not in the manifesto. If we were to reorganise it would have to be worth it, with substantial powers and matching funding. Otherwise it may be a costly distraction when we have our backs to the wall and should be focussing on the recovery from covid.

Lincolnshire Reorganisation?

In Lincolnshire, our Councils already make significant savings by joint working and shared services and still keeping our identity and strong sense of democratic accountability to you, our residents.

The County Council Leader has written to government in readiness to reorganise, as before, which, last time, I fought against, successfully with colleagues.

A very large organisation is often unwieldy and hard for residents to influence. The June monthly poll showed that 87% of people were satisfied or very satisfied with their local Council. I am not sure what the figure would be for national government.

Recovery

Whilst committees were closed at Council, our Independent Group got busy creating a strategy document on Recovery.

We are especially keen to recognise that the problems of damage to our environment still need dealing with at the same time as an economic recovery, dealing with significant unemployment and mental health or other issues arising from Covid. We need a recovery that covers our local economy and jobs, our community and our environment. A copy is on the web at www.lincolnshireindependents.org.uk

The Council's committees are working reasonably well online, and hopefully soon all back to full size.

Your View on Recycling

How can we get more of our waste recycled? The Lincolnshire Waste partnership is setting up an advisory panel. I hope we can have a good number of local residents included, as the advisory body will help set policy. As a critical thinker, focussing on residents' needs, you will be exactly right. More localised drop off points, stable and simple criteria on what is recyclable. For that we need contracts with companies that take a wider range of materials, even if not quite as advantageous in price at first sight.

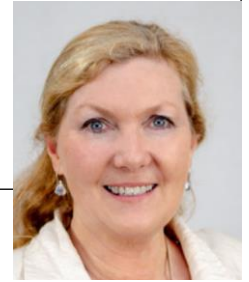
Full Planning of the new smaller committee of 20 members is on August 6th at 2pm.
