Cllr Mary Green writes:

As things appear to be moving toward a more 'normal' way of life it will be good to hold meetings face to face in the future - looking forward to it, whilst remaining socially distanced of course!

- The Boundary Commission is undergoing a review on the political constituencies to ensure that the number of electors in each constituency is more equal so that each member of parliament is representing between 69,724 and 77,062. You can view the proposals for the North Kesteven District at the Boundary Commission website. The initial proposals have been released and the consultation stage is open for comments until 2 August 2021.

- NKDC has been shortlisted by Investors in People in the top 20 of its Gold 250+ award category. The top 20 will be whittled down to a top 10 and announced in September, with the number one spot revealed in November at the Investors in People Awards 2021
- Recycling rates have gone down in NKDC. We were once among the highest for quality recycling but have now fallen to 44% - less than the Government's target of 50%. A new bin (purple lidded) which has been trialled in the district will be introduced later in the year. It is for clean uncontaminated cardboard & paper - so no pizza boxes! In taking it out of the current green bin and keeping it clean and dry it is hoped 98% will be recyclable and saleable at around £65 per ton.
- New rail pass & vouchers for popular tourist attractions are part of a plan to return domestic tourism to pre pandemic levels. The Tourism Recovery Plan aims to help the sector build back better. Further information at NKDC website.
- The brand new 'Heart of Lincs Visitor Guide' for 2021 is out now, for the best of our districts events and activities it can be downloaded online via the NKDC website.
- Covid figures published up to Thursday 24 June 2021 for the county show increases recorded in all 7 districts. 8 of the 13 MSOA's (Middle Layer Super Output Area) in NK had a suppressed figure (i.e. between zero and two cases in each) in the most recent week.
- Notification from Highways England of continued maintenance works on both north and south bound carriageways of the A46 between the M1 at Leicester and the A57 Carholme roundabout at Lincoln. Resurfacing of sections of the carriageway, some slip roads, refresh road markings and renew road studs. The next phase of work is planned to start on Friday 30 July 2021 and is scheduled for completion early November 2021. To maintain a safe working environment various sections of the A46 will need to close along with the adjoining exit and entry slips. To minimise disruption workings will be overnight Monday to Friday between 8pm and 6am excluding Bank Holidays. During the closures diversion routes will be put in place as agreed with local authorities. Please allow extra time when planning any journeys.
