Cllr Mary Green wrote (7/4/22):

I hope you are all managing to keep as fit and well as is possible under these unusual circumstances.

What funny weather we have been having too, let us hope it settles down to a bright spring and brilliant summer.

Generally, so far, this month is proving to be quiet. The main pieces that may be of interest are as follows:-

- *Lincolnshire is preparing to receive its first Ukrainian evacuees after hundreds of families reached out to offer sanctuary. In tandem with the preparations being made in homes across the county, a network of local councils, other public bodies, charities and community groups is continuing to develop, in partnership, a range of services and mechanisms to underpin the*

response. The various councils and organisations contributing to the response have been working hard on understanding the emerging guidance and putting processes in place such as well-being support, safeguarding measures and checks. They are also working on aligning health and education provision and with voluntary and charitable sector partners in developing a broader range of responses and 'wrap-around' support, plus a community fund for local giving. Information about donation collections and charity fundraising has been collated on the NKDC website.

- *Time for a Cuppa Week 1st to 8th May 2022 in aid of Dementia UK. I'm sharing this date in case anyone would like to take part or get involved in organising a tea-based gathering to raise funds and connect with their communities. Further info available by visiting the Dementia UK website.*
- *Payments for the £150 Council Tax Energy Rebate will start to be distributed from the end of April - visit NKDC website for more details.*
- *Covid safe protocols are still in force at the Sleaford offices, they apply to visitors, members and partners using the building. They include the wearing of masks, if people find themselves within 2 metres of someone, unless exemptions apply.*
