Monthly report from Cllr Mary Green:

"National housing order is now in place across England. All poultry and other captive birds must be kept indoors to help prevent the spread of Avian Influenza (bird flu).

- Rural England Prosperity Fund NK has been allocated £747,556 to use in line with Rural Fund's aims, and so the council is proposing a range of capital grant schemes that include - Support for small rural businesses, large capital projects and from the wider visitor economy in the district. A grant scheme that will support communities and community groups aiming to make an investment in projects that will benefit the community or contribute to the district reaching net zero. The two key priorities of the Rural Fund are focussed on supporting rural, small businesses and entrepreneurs to either start-up, scale up or expand and helping rural communities to enhance digital infrastructure, community infrastructure and local green spaces and community-led projects. - The Heart of Lincs Visitor Guide is compiling the 2023 edition, Closing date for submitting a listing is this Friday 11 November 2022 - email <u>heartoflincs@-n-kesteven.gov.uk</u> to book, or obtain more information.
- The Police & Crime Commissioner is inviting responses to an online survey about how residents want the county to be policed. The 10 minute online survey is where you can air your opinions, the results from past surveys have influenced decisions taken about how and where to deploy policing resources. See NKDC website for details.
- A reminder that the Central Lincolnshire Local Plan Examination Hearing begins on Tuesday 15 November 2022. The Local Plan was submitted in July 2022 for examination. The Local Plan contains the planning policies that are intended to be applied in Central Lincolnshire and used to make decisions on planning applications, and contain site allocations to meet growth needs to 2040.
- Stamp Replacement as of 1 February 2023, stamps will no longer be in use. These will be replaced with a bar code. Stamps can be used up to 31 January 2023, and after this date any left-over stamps will be able to be swapped for the new bar codes.
- Bassingham has recently had an outline planning application (22/1405/OUT) for 25 homes on an Entry Level Exception Site. This is a new type of application, indeed the first of its kind for NKDC, I will be

following this one with interest. If anyone would like to look at the application please visit planning online at NKDC and quote the above reference.

- Carlton le Moorland have an outline planning application for 6 dwellings at the Corner Farm site, just as you enter the village off Bassingham road. Reference 22/1563/OUT.
- I hope you all had safe and enjoyable Bonfire nights, although pets and wildlife are not so keen. I have seen more people on media letting neighbours know they were having fireworks at a certain time, more consideration such as that is to be encouraged. Organisers of events involving fireworks can notify NKDC, so the council can then list when and where such events are taking place and residents can check for their area."

2023 Meeting dates

2023 will be a Local Elections year to be held 4th May 2023. In an election year, the "old Council" retires on the Monday following the day of elections, when the new Council comes into being. The new Council must hold its Annual (and first) Meeting within a fortnight from that Monday.

And the Annual Parish Meeting must be held each year between March 1st and June 1st . Because this is a meeting of a body separate from the Parish Council (see above) the date is not affected by the Parish Council election cycle.
