The many heartfelt cards and messages with them will be kept with the Book of Condolence, which has now closed in accordance with guidance from the Palace, it is to be archived.

NKDC physical meetings have now resumed following the period of mourning

- Electoral Commission Members of the public can have their say on measures to improve polling station accessibility until 17 October 2022. Responses will be used to shape Electoral Commission guidance to help understand barriers faced by people with disabilities and make informed decisions about how to make voting easier and more accessible. Online forms can be completed on the Commission's website.
- Be aware of a fraud circulating by text and email regarding the £400 Energy Bills Support Scheme, purporting to be from HM Government. There is NO need to register for this scheme or supply bank details, energy suppliers will automatically apply the discount to bills.
- Reminder of the ongoing road works on the A17 between Sleaford Road Beckingham and Leadenham Low Fields, it is the road being closed overnight between 7pm and 6am, weekday nights only, However there will be some weekend working required from 7pm Friday night until 6am on the following Monday morning - the proposed weekends are 30 September to 3 October, 7-10 October and 14-17 October.
