### **All Saints news**

A very HUGE thank you to all those who contributed, supported and attended our recent fundraiser the Summer Craft, Food and Produce Fair. We raised a staggering £1104.16 and are now nearly halfway towards having enough funds for the new lighting scheme.

As the PCC we have to firstly fund the day to day expenses of the church and these are covered by Service Collections, Planned Giving, the Willows Trust, the Highway Trust and the Parish Council who contribute toward the mowing of the churchyard. Our main outgoings are the Parish Share, paid to Lincoln Diocese to contribute to Clergy Salaries and insurance and alarm system. We receive no monies from Lincoln Diocese. The funding for the external restoration (namely the roof and tower) has come largely from English Heritage with other smaller grants from the Listed Places of Worship Scheme, the Headley Trust, the Garfield Weston Foundation and the Allchurches Trust. But English Heritage and many other funders do not offer any funding for internal restoration projects and therefore although these are essential projects such as lighting and heating schemes, we, the PCC have to persist in fundraising in order to find a large percentage of the necessary costs.
