- 5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday**, 5th **May 2016**.

- 7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at North Kesteven District Council, Council Offices, Kesteven Street, Sleaford NG34 7EF by 5pm on Tuesday, 19th April 2016.
- Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at North Kesteven District Council, Council Offices, Kesteven Street, Sleaford NG34 7EF by 5 pm on Tuesday, 26th April 2016.
- 9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at North Kesteven District Council, Council Offices, Kesteven Street, Sleaford NG34 7EF by 5pm on 5 May 2016. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Tuesday 26 April 2016.
